The Restless Pines Fall Finale is a sanctioned **Gold C National** competition of **Equine Canada**, 2685 Queensveiw Drive, Suite 100, Ottawa, ON, K2B 8K2 and is governed by the rules and specifications of EC. A602.1 Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the EC Rule Book and amendments and will be held and judged in accordance with said EC Rule book.

The Restless Pines Fall Finale, its Management, Organizing Committee, Officials or Show Staff are in no way responsible for accident, injury or damage to any rider, exhibitor, spectator, groom, attendant, trainer or other employee; or animals, nor theft, loss or damage to animals, vehicles or equipment.

Any rule not covered by the Equine Canada rules and regulations will be covered by the competition management.

STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE

The Equine*Hippique Canada (EC), the National Federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction. The EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agent use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

Any owner/rider who competes in a division in which he/she is not eligible to compete will be liable to disciplinary action by the EC. EC current competitive membership is required for all owners, lessees, riders, drivers, agents and trainers competing in EC recognized competitions excepting individual associate members competing in their own breed affiliate competitions.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN:

- Current Certified First Aid person will be available throughout the competition.
- In event of an accident – P.A. system will call to see if a medical doctor may be on the grounds, if not 911 will be called.
- Phone # for veterinarian on call will be posted at the in-gate and in the Office.

INSURANCE: Participants at Restless Pines Fall Finale Horse Show are required to have third party liability insurance. Proof of coverage for riders and owners must accompany entry form.

MEMBERSHIPS: Competitors must have current Equine Canada Gold Memberships to compete at this show.

PASSPORTS: G110. Current up-to-date passports are required for all hunters and jumpers competing in EC rated classes and are to be passed in at the office BEFORE RING NUMBER WILL BE ISSUED. The registration number of each passport must be on every entry form for the corresponding horse at all EC shows. Failure to comply with the above will result in the following: 1st offence – warning; 2nd offence – fine. Refer to A405, A406, A407.

Temporary passports can be purchased at the show office.

HEADGEAR: Article A905, EC Rule Book. **All** competitors must wear properly fitted, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured at all times while mounted at the competition or anywhere on the show grounds.

HORS CONCOURS: Not Permitted A808

DOGS: Must be kept on a leash at all times while on the show grounds.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING FEES

JUMP CANADA BOARD LEVY: \$10 per horse or pony entered in an Equine Canada hunter division will be remitted to the JCB in order to support their development programs.

EQUINE MEDICATION CONTROL: Fee of \$7.00 per horse or pony competing in EC divisions must accompany entry. A602.5 Any horse entered in a class in a competition subject to the requirement to pay drug testing fees may, while on the competition grounds and on the recommendation of the chair of the Provincial Equine Medication Control Committee or the chair's appointee, be selected for medication control testing.

STABLING: Limited stabling available on site. Fees for stabling will be \$30 per day or part day in permanent barns or \$20 per day / part day in temporary. Bedding can be ordered on entry form @ \$7 per bag. Stabling preference may be given to those travelling the furthest distance. Stalls must be cleaned out by competitor prior to departure from grounds. \$10 stall deposit – refunded upon cleaning prior to leaving

COMPETITION ADMINISTRATION FEE: \$25.00 per entry form.

HARMONIZED SALES TAX: Restless Pines Farm is a registered business, and as such must collect HST on any show fees not passed on to a second party. HST # 86293 7596 RT0001

LATE FEE: \$ 20.00 per late entry form. Any entry received after closing date of September 10th will be considered late entries. **Entries will not be accepted without payment.**

SCRATCHES: If any entry is scratched 24 hours prior to commencement of competition entry fees will be refunded in full less administration fees and any applicable stabling fees.

Once competition has commenced no fees will be refunded without an original copy of Doctor or Veterinarian certificate. The admin fee and any stabling fees are non refundable. Owners will be liable for all fees if not scratched in this manner.

Championships: All EC Divisions will receive Championships, points to be tabulated per EC rules.

Awards: Ribbons 1st to 6th place, prize money as noted in each division.

Any division with less than 4 entries subsequent to the entry deadline will be awarded ribbons only – no prize money.

Restless Pines Classic Classes/Divisions

HUNTER DIVISIONS: G501, G507. Over fences classes to be judged on performance, manners, way of going and hunting soundness. Conformation not considered. Under saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; at least eight horses, at the judge's discretion, if available, may be required to gallop one way in the ring, but never more than eight at one time (pre-green hunters do not gallop). Light contact with horse's mouth is permissible. In order to maintain awards, horses must compete and complete the course in at least one over fence class in their respective division. Miscellaneous hunter class not to gallop. Entries may be refused an award unless they return to the ring for soundness in a complete bridle.

The show committee reserves the right to combine or cancel divisions should there not be sufficient entries available. All Hunter Divisions will be run with back to back rounds.
